Kade Baker



Kade was stillborn. He was resituated twice, and brought back to life. My grandma played a big role on it. She told me the day before she died she was going to take him. She died on November 07,2017. Kade was born on 12-13-2017. Therefore She did take him. In between the first, and second resitation I spoke to my grandma, and he was brought back for the second time. He has been alive since then. I didn't know he had seizures, or anything until I enrolled him in preschool. Before preschool he was the normal fun, loving, outgoing, and speedy, polite, and well behaved kid. When I put him in preschool they noticed he was having some starring spells, complaining of legs hurting, and more. I told the family doctor they referred him back to Columbus at nationwide children's hospital. Which we was already affiliated with due to he has asthma, and his lung collapsed at 6 weeks old. That's how we found out he has asthma. When they referred him to a neurologist I took him. He did a EEG, and MRI on him. It was hard seeing him with all the stuff on him. That's how he was at birth. He spent a week in NICU also. They called me the very next day, and told me he has focal epilepsy, and absences seizures. They also told me they wanted to put him on medicine right away also. It's been a trial and error with medicine. He's on trilipital, LamoTRlgine for his seizures he's on valtoco for his rescue medicine. He has ADHD, left sided weakness, developmental delay, asthma, focal epilepsy, absence seizures, and insomnia. He's been through, but he tried to not let it stop him. He tries to be the normal outgoing, fun, loving kid he was before. Sometimes we have set backs to where we can't get outside or do anything due to his focal epilepsy. Part of the focal epilepsy is his legs being weak, and giving out on him to where he falls. Lately I carry him outside, and he sits. Sometimes he doesn't even feel good enough to even sit outside. His neurologist transferred his care over to a complex epilepsy clinic. I am hoping we get more answers, find out more things, and we can find out what works best for Kade. I am trying to get him back to the boy he was before. I know he will never be the same. It has held us back from doing things we love, and much more. Thanks to Jacy's wagons I will be able to take my son to the zoo when he gets his wagon. The Monroe county board of developmental disabilities, and family council in woodsfield, Ohio went together and they are getting Kade tickets to the zoo. He's been wanting to go to the zoo forever, but I haven't took him because of his legs and all. So now we will be able to go with the wagon he is going to be receiving. I love you Jacy's wagons so much, and thank you guys for everything. You all mean more to me than you ever know, and hold a special place in my heart. Now because of Jacy's wagons we can try to take my son to do more things with him,, and go more places with Kade. Attached is Kade, and me at a block party in new Martinsville wv. Where I'm from. Well I'm from actually wileyville, WV . He's playing with Legos. He loves animals, Legos, Yoda from Star wars, his Nationwide children's teddy bear his uncle michael mozena bought him when we first started at Columbus (he has passed) he takes that bear everywhere with him. His favorite color is blue. He said God is above and that's why he loves blue.
