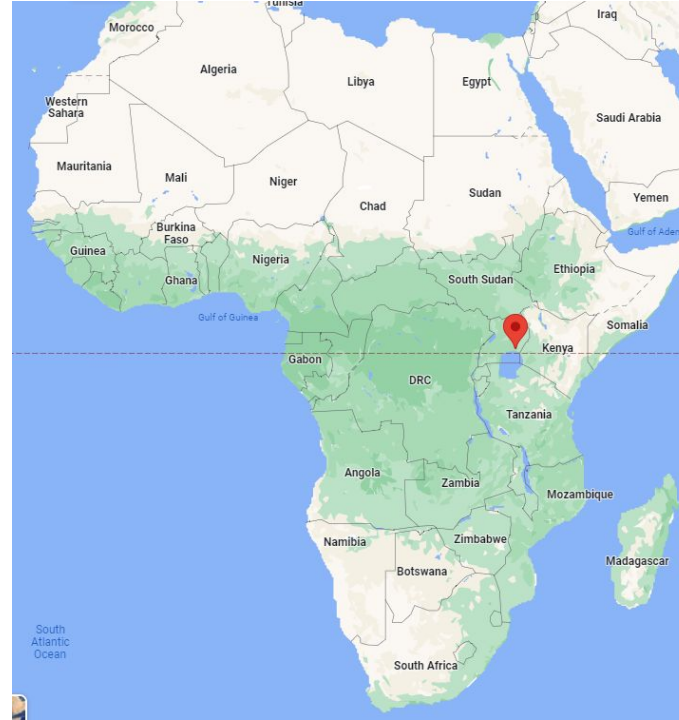
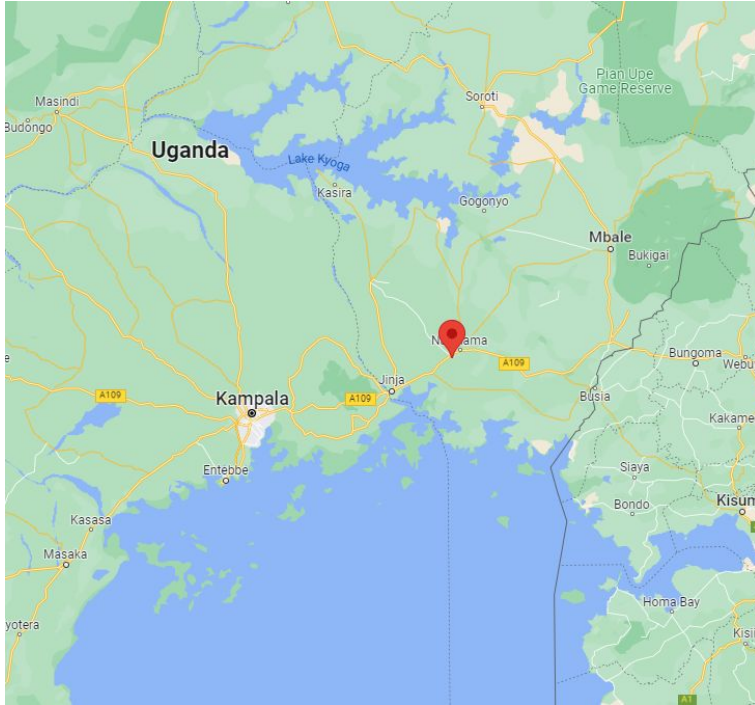


Iganga Community Brass Band Music School
