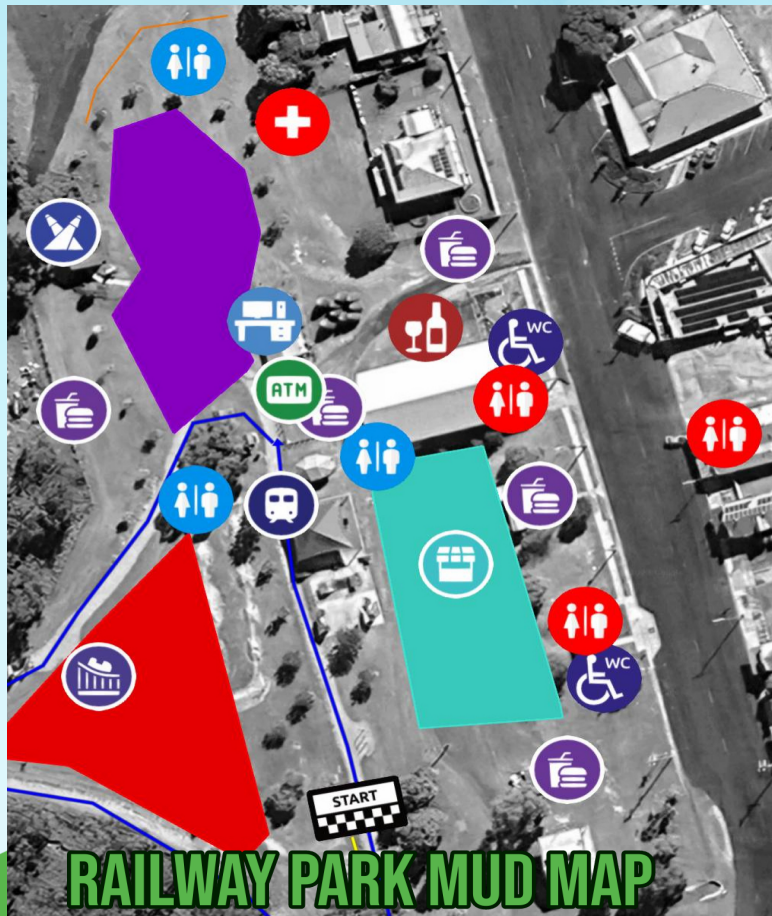


# USEFUL THINGS TO KNOW

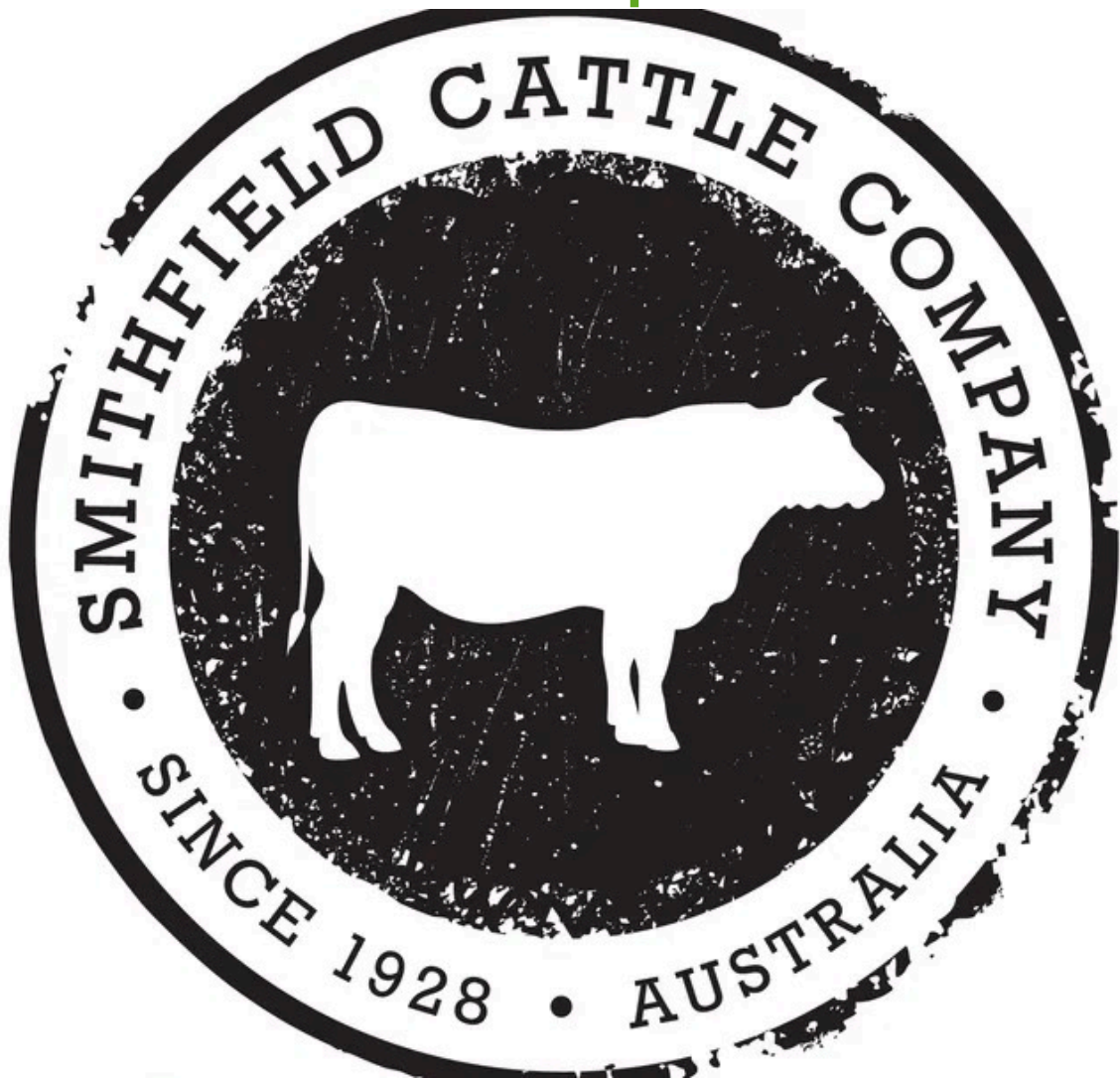
