

How to Clean & Maintain Reglazed Surfaces

Please follow the below instructions for your new reglazed surfaces: Fiberglass tub, Porcelain tub, Vanity Counter, Kitchen Counter, sinks, or any reglazed surface.

Recommended Cleaning

Products:

- *Scrubbing Bubbles.*
- *Formula 409(without bleach).*
- *Lysol Basin Tub and Tile Cleaner.*
- **Use Dish Soap in a Pinch, you can safely use gentle liquid dish soap, such as Dawn, Palmolive, to clean a reglazed surface.*
- ***Materials:*** *Non-abrasive cleaner, sponge, microfiber cloth, or soft-bristle nylon brush, soft towel or rag.*

Avoid These Cleaning

Methods:

- *Do not use abrasives such as, harsh or gritty cleaners, rough sponges, Scotch-Brite, steel wool.*
- *Powered Cleaners such as Ajax or Comet.*
- *Ammonia or Bleach.*

Warning will cause damage:

- Suction cup mats on tubs.
- Leaky faucets, hair dye, ink, will stain or damage tub surface.
- Hot pans, cutting on counters, candles, and ink will damage counters surface.
