TREASURER'S REPORT:

- \$1,391.90 (estimated)
- Cindy announced that Bruce Nall will be stepping away from his position as KCAG Treasurer, and Steve McCall volunteered to take his place. Cindy Marshall, Steve McCall and Bruce Nall will plan to meet at KCAG's Credit Union at a time and date TBD, and execute the formal documents/signatures required for Steve to officially assume the Treasurer's responsibilities.

OLD BUSINESS:

- **KCAG Show a Columbine Library**
 - Due to unexpected openings, KCAG members were afforded several extra months of group and solo displays at the Columbine library
 - Jan: Hosted the originally scheduled KCAG Group show
 - Feb: Extension of KCAG Group show
 - Mar: Joint print show by Cindy Marshall and Donna Schnitzer
 - Apr: Solo textile show by Judy Ahlborn
 - Cindy reported that additional solo show opportunities were available for KCAG members, and that Alexis McDowell had already expressed interest in a future show.

- **Jeffco High School Art Show**

- Bruce Nall, Karen Morjig, and Judy Ahlborn were this year's KCAG judging representatives at the Jeffco Schools Foundation High School Art Exhibit at the Arvada Center
- Out of many deserving pieces, the selection went to Saige LeFleur of Dakota Ridge HS, and was awarded a \$100 Certificate from KCAG for her outstanding work.



- **Participation in the 2024 KC Art Festival**

- KCAG will participate in the 2024 KCR Art Festival held on Saturday, June 29, from 11am to 4pm.
- The KCAG Member Show will be upstairs in the Shaffer Room, and be independent of the Resident's show downstairs in the Bradford Room.
- KCAG setup would probably occur the day before, on Friday, June 28.
- The KCAG artworks could be NFS or available for sale, but the details of the transactions must be handled privately between buyer and artist.
- Deadline for resident registration is May 15, while images of artworks must be submitted by June 3. KCAG will jury the artworks, while KCR will be responsible for awards.
- KCR would provide food trucks, music, and other entertainment for the event, with KCAG possibly augmenting the activities with art-oriented demonstrations of chalk art, face painting, pastel drawing, pottery, or jewelry, depending on member interest and availability (TBD later).
- A call for KCAG member participation will be issued shortly.
