"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth," (Acts 1:8, ESV).

The celebration of Easter begins with movement. At the Easter Vigil, the saints gather outside the sanctuary as a new fire is kindled and they await the announcement of Jesus' resurrection. After the candles are lit, the assembly moves into the church to hear the ancient stories of God's redemption of His people and to receive the risen Christ present in His Holy Supper. Easter begins with movement into the church...

Easter ends with the movement of the Church. While the Easter season also includes the disciples cowering behind locked doors for fear of the Jews, and returning to the familiar confines of fishing on the Sea of Galilee, Jesus prepares His disciples for movement. To the ends of the earth, Christ bids His disciples go as His witnesses. Empowered by the Holy Spirit, the saints of every generation are part of the Church's movement to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Rather than sitting in safety, the Church boldly moves into the world as God brings His Kingdom to the least and lowly, to those who are far off, and to all whom the Lord God will call.

German Lutheran pastor Wilhelm Loehe wrote, "Mission is nothing but the one church of God in motion." As Christians mark our Lord's ascension and prepare for Pentecost, our prayer is that our congregations would be marked by movement, not simply the movement from the parking lot to the pew, but a movement of mission, boldly proclaiming the risen and ascended Christ, who reigns on high. Faithful Lutherans do not hide behind closed doors, but move out into the world, serving in their various callings as God uses them to be salt and light wherever He leads. May this movement not be limited to a season of the Church Year, but truly flow from the Holy Spirit's kindling within us—

Mustard Seed Daily Devotions The Race of Faith: Suit Up Starting Out — Suit Up

In the Word- For as many of you as were baptized into Christ put on Christ (Galatians 3:27).

Of the Word- Many different kinds of running clothes are made by a variety of companies. These brand names adorn the runner from head to foot and everything in between. Running gear may be chosen for attractiveness, functionality, or price; but chances are, something you wear while running boasts a brand name.

While God doesn't care about clothing brand names, He does care about what we wear. In fact, He gave us clothing to wear at all times while we run the race of life. Saint Paul wrote those who were *baptized into Christ put on Christ* (Galatians 3:27). In other words, He clothes us with His own righteousness. We are, in fact, covered head to toe with Jesus!

Jesus has a specific purpose for the clothing He gave us. When we put on Christ each day, we should be showing Him to others. Our thoughts, words, and actions can all reflect His righteousness. So instead of becoming a billboard for popular clothing brands, become a billboard of Christ's love. From head to feet and everything in between, show the love of Christ to the world.

Walking with my Lord- Heavenly Father, through my baptism, You have clothed me with righteousness. As I put on Christ each day, help me to reflect that righteousness to the world around me. In Jesus' name I pray. Amen.
