Preparation:

Print your letter, fill it out and sign it. Place it in an envelope marked:

PETITION TO HM THE KING

Buckingham Palace London SW1A 1AA

(No stamp is required) ref. UK Post Scheme 23.2

Do this even if you are going to petition in person. It is a useful precaution.

Although many Petition Letters will end up being posted by Royal Mail, the exercise of meeting up is to demonstrate strength of feeling on the subject whilst having the protection of the law in petitioning The King directly (in London) or to his local representative (Your county Lord Lieutenant)

Overseas.

Petition Letters may be sent from overseas if you are away. You will have to pay postage on these.
