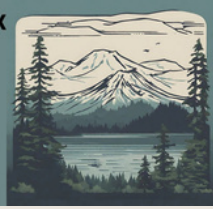


TAX RESOLUTION: A STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE

Tax Preparation
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1. ASSESS YOUR TAX SITUATION

- ☐ Review IRS notices and determine the nature of the issue
- ☐ Identify the tax years involved

2. GATHER NECESSARY DOCUMENTATION

- ☐ Recent tax returns
- ☐ IRS correspondence
- ☐ Financial records (income, expenses, assets)

3. CONSULT WITH A TAX PROFESSIONAL

- ☐ Seek advice from a certified tax advisor or attorney
- ☐ Discuss potential resolution options

4. CHOOSE A RESOLUTION OPTION

- ☐ Determine the most suitable resolution method
- ☐ Understand eligibility requirements

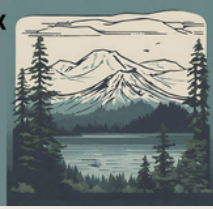
5. PREPARING THE RETURN AND WAITING FOR THE IRS
