A CLOSER LOOK

In 2016, there were roughly 3 million more STEM jobs than the number of skilled workers who could fill them. In 2017, direct STEM employment accounted for 69% of US GDP. By 2018, 80% of engineering and technology decision makers had significant concern about a talent gap in their industry. For each cybersecurity opening, there was a pool of only 2.3 employed workers from which to recruit (vs an average of 5.8 workers in the overall job market).^{*} If we are to ensure that we have the talent pool available to meet both current and future needs, we must work proactively to raise awareness and ensure that we equip students of all ages with the critical STEM skills necessary to participate fully in the STEM economy.
