

Options for Booties for dragging/knuckling

1. **Kooltail Dog Socks** – Lightweight socks, anti slip, waterproof, detachable straps

Pros: easy to put on, waterproof, has detachable strap so stays on well, rubberized at bottom for traction



2. **Pawz Booties**- Lightweight rubber booties

Pros: usually well tolerated, no mess, work well, can be left on most of the day (check for irritation or swelling), can be worn outside, cheap, provide some nail protection if needed, effective, safe for floors

Cons: will wear through quickly if you dog drags their nails at all, some dogs don't like booties



3. **Gripper Dog Socks**- sock with wrap around traction/rubber

Pros: easy to put on, lightweight, no mess, can be left on most of the day, can be worn outside, cheap, sturdier if dog drags nails, provide nail protection if needed, effective, safe for floors

Cons: may need to add Velcro or tape strap to keep on, some dogs don't like booties



4. **No knuckling training sock** – helps keep toes from dragging

Pros: Helps toes stay up during walking
