

# EMU ISLAND DIET

## INGREDIENTS

1. Non medicated Base Feed (see choices below)
2. Show Hutch Deluxe 17 Rabbit nuggets
3. Rooster Booster Poultry Boost PELLETS
4. Vitamin B Complex

## CHOOSE A BASE FEED



- a) **Chicks-young juveniles:** Quality non-medicated feed: 18% Starter Grower feed with prebiotics, probiotics, amino acids, and strong vitamin support. Nutrena Naturewise Chick Starter or Purina Start & Grow NON-MEDICATED are both good choices.
- b) **6 months old and up:** Quality non-medicated Layer feed with prebiotics, probiotics, antioxidants, and vitamin E support. Nutrena Naturewise or Purina Layena are good choices;  
or
- c) Ratite or Emu Feed such as Mazuri, Kalmbach or another brand. (Check individual brands for age recommendations.)

- **Chicks-young juveniles: Mix 50% Base Feed with 50% Show Hutch**
- **6 Months-Adults: Mix 75% base feed with 25% Show Hutch**

## IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE WE STRONGLY RECOMMEND

Rooster Booster Poultry Boost PELLETS (this specific brand and type). This is an essential vitamin and nutrient for emus.

Sprinkle on top every morning for chicks.

At least twice a week for adults.

Add just enough to very lightly tint the water.
