Materials for Submission & Directions - All materials are to be combined into one PDF document

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Sign the publicity release.
- 3. Official transcript indicating cumulative PT/PTA specific GPA.
- 4. Nominee statement:
 - a. Two-page limit,12-point font, one-inch margins.
 - b. Nominee statement should provide a clear, concise statement, discussing evidence of a leadership role in addressing current issues in physical therapy, participation in state and national APTA activities, how your education and experiences have prepared you for a career in physical therapy and how you plan to contribute to the profession in the next three to five years.
- 5. Verification of credit hours signed by the department chair in the PT/PTA department at your school. The applicant may not verify credit hours.
- 6. Include a photo (head shot).
- 7. Sign the publicity release.

Prepare all of the materials for submission into <u>one PDF file</u> and email to <u>info@gfptonline.org</u> by Monday, February 28, 2022. Be sure your packet is complete as incomplete nomination packets will not be considered by the GFPT Scholarship Committee. There will be no follow up with students regarding incomplete applications.
