

Mission Statement

Our mission here at Life As You Know It Dance LLC is to provide any and all entry level dancers an opportunity for a place to grow, to feel safe, to be themselves , and to have fun.

Dance Dues

Dance Dues are \$50 per student. Dance Dues are monthly payments for training. Dues go towards paying teachers, building space, and other items & equipment that may be used during the season. Also can be used towards parties & events that are hosted by the company. PAYMENTS

ARE DUE BY THE 1ST OF EACH MONTH. A late fee of \$10.00 will be applied to ALL payments received after the 10th of each month. June Dance Dues must be paid by June 1st. NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!

All payments and fees can be paid by going on the website (www.lifeasyouknowitjj.com/registration) and clicking the PAY NOW button. In the "notes" section please list the student's name along with what the payment is for.

Dance dues payments are based on a 10-month schedule (September-June). Students with an outstanding balance will not be able to participate in class until monthly payment has been received. Full dues are due every month regardless of vacation days, snow days and holidays. If dance dues are not paid in full for all 10 months by June 1st, the dancer will not be able to participate in the end of the season showcase.

Expectations & Rules

- Arrive to class on time
- No chewing gum during class

- NO laziness (dancing full out at all times)
 - Keep language and behavior clean
- Be kind and respectful to one another (don't make fun or laugh at others)
- Dress appropriate (no jeans or tight pants , wear sneakers or jazz shoes & loose fitted clothes to dance in)
 - Please keep conversation to a minimum during class.
 - No talking while instructor is teaching/ talking
- STAY HYDRATED (bring plenty of water or juice also snacks for break. **NO** SODA)
- Everyone is responsible for purchasing their own costumes for each
 piece they are in (slip on black jazz shoes are required for dance
 class. MUST have by Sept)

Attendance

Attendance is mandatory for all students. Majority of our classes requires new choreography being taught and all dancers are a major factor.

Multiple missed classes will result in a student falling behind. If a student

has fallen behind they will be asked to set up a private session with the instructor to get caught up. NO refunds for any missed classes. Please let us know in advance if you will be late or absent.

Discipline

We offer a fun and positive learning experience for all students and want everyone to be comfortable. Disrespectful and disruptive students will be asked to sit out of class if spoken to more than once. Recurring disciplinary problems will be discussed with parents and, if necessary, the student may be asked to withdrawal from classes if the behavior continues and becomes an issue. NO refunds will be made! We have ZERO tolerance for disrespectful students. Here at LAYKI we are a family and work as a team. Students are expected to be on their best behavior while in class or while out representing the company.

Private Lessons

One and a half hours long private lessons will be offered to students who have fallen behind in class and need or request extra help with any dances. \$15 per lesson due at the time of lesson.

Competition

Competition info will be given as we go. Any participants that would like to compete must pay any fees required plus their monthly Dance dues and purchase any costumes needed.
