My name is Cynthia Westbrook. I am eighteen (18) years of age or older, of sound mind, and fully capable of making this affidavit. I am personally acquainted with the facts stated herein, and I hereby declare the following:

1. I am a current member of the Board of Directors of the Friends of Opus 76 Quartet.
2. I was present at the purported Board meeting held on October 4, 2025.
3. During the meeting, I raised concerns that the gathering did not constitute a properly convened meeting of the Board.
4. I further objected that Janet Giesling, the mother of Ashley Stanfield, was not a member of the Board of Directors.
5. I also objected that Stephen Offenbach was not a member of the Board of Directors.
6. I expressed concern that I had not been provided a copy of the organization's bylaws and did not believe that the October 4, 2025 meeting had been properly noticed or called as an authorized Board meeting.
7. No motion was made by the Board at the October 4, 2025 meeting to remove Keith Stanfield from his position.
8. No vote of the Board was taken at the October 4, 2025 meeting to remove Keith Stanfield from his position.
9. I did not agree to inform Mr. Stanfield that he had been dismissed, as stated in the purported "Minutes: Friends of Opus 76 Quartet Board Meeting" dated October 4, 2025.

10. I did not state that I would seek to find a replacement for a temporary assignment until an executive director could be appointed, as represented in the purported meeting minutes dated October 4, 2025.

11. I am aware that Ashley Stanfield is involved in divorce proceedings with Keith Stanfield.

12. When Janet Giesling discussed matters relating to her daughter, Ashley Stanfield, and the divorce proceedings with Keith Stanfield during the meeting, I believed such matters were inappropriate for discussion at a Board meeting.

13. The statements made in this affidavit are based on my personal knowledge and are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information, and belief.
