Known children of Sarah² Noggle and George Hile were as follows:

- 3 i. JOHN HILE, born 09 October 1836, Ohio; died 14 November 1914, Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky;¹ married (1) Margaret Jane Teeters,² and (2) Melissa Neville.³
- 4 ii. MARY C. HILE, born 1838, Ohio;⁴ died 1875, Wayne County, Ohio;⁵ married O.W. Fouch.⁶
- 5 iii. ELIZABETH ANN HILE, born 06 March 1840, Wayne County, Ohio; died 01 December 1919, Harlan, Allen County, Indiana;⁷ Henry W. Moore.⁸

- 6 iv. WILSON S. HILE, born 14 July 1842, Ohio; died 30 October 1920, Akron, Summit County, Ohio;⁹ married Mary Jane McFillen.¹⁰
- 7 v. GEORGE WASHINGTON HILE, born 27 November 1844, Ohio; died 30 December 1922, Garrett, De Kalb County, Indiana;¹¹ married Leola Mary Bell.¹²
- 8 vi. IRA C. HILE, born 12 February 1847, Ashland County, Ohio; died 10 August 1897, Big Prairie, Holmes County, Ohio;¹³ died unmarried.¹⁴
- 9 vii. NANCY J. HILE, born 30 July 1847, Wayne County, Ohio; died 31 December 1913 Franklin, Wayne county, Ohio;¹⁵ married George Washington Knox.¹⁶
- 10 viii. ANNA BARBRY HILE, born 01 May 1849, Ohio; died 13 March 1931, Goshen, Elkhart County, Indiana;¹⁷ married John W. Stringfellow.¹⁸
