In 1854, "An Act to provide for the Proof, Acknowledgment, and Recording of Deeds, and other Instruments of Writing," that passed on 22 February 1831 was still in force. Section 2 for "Deeds made by husband and wife" required that both husband and wife sign the deed, that both husband and wife attested to and acknowledged the deed before a legal office as described in Section 1, including a Justice of the Peace, and the wife examined separately and apart from her husband and the contents of the deed or conveyance made known to her. The office was also to certify the acknowledgement of the deed and the examination of the wife, and sign his name.

The Holmes County Courthouse was established when the county was formed but was destroyed by fire 9 years later in 1834.

Migration

- **Amish** (Swiss, German, Alsatian usually) migrated to Holmes Co from PA in the 1810s-1820s. Often these Amish came from Lancaster, Mifflin, Somerset, Berks, and Chester Counties, PA.
- **Germans** directly from Germany or PA came to Holmes in the 1820s-1850s predominantly.
- **Swiss Mennonites** arrived in the mid-1800s, especially to the southern part of Holmes.
- **Welsh** settled in the western townships in the 1830s-1840s.
- **Irish** settlers often arrived to work on the railroad mid-century.
- **English** and **Scots Irish** settled in Holmes the entire nineteenth century usually as farmers.

Tips:

- Dates are mixed so keep searching forward and backward when browsing.
- The click-through indexed FS search does NOT give death record results.
- Death records are located at the end of volumes 1-4 on two different microfilms found on the landing page linked above. Browse through them to find the record based on approximate date and then likely grouping by township. Volumes 1 & 2, then 3 & 4 are combined, so browsing must be done twice within each digitized set.
- Delayed birth records are indexed at the beginning of Vol. 1.

Marriage Records (Probate Court)

Marriage records appear fully extant from county inception in 1824. Tips:

- Records are indexed but date-range browsing can also be helpful if one isn't found that is expected.
- Browse parent (Wayne, Coshocton, and Tuscarawas to the east) and other contiguous counties although the linked search above does include all Ohio counties.

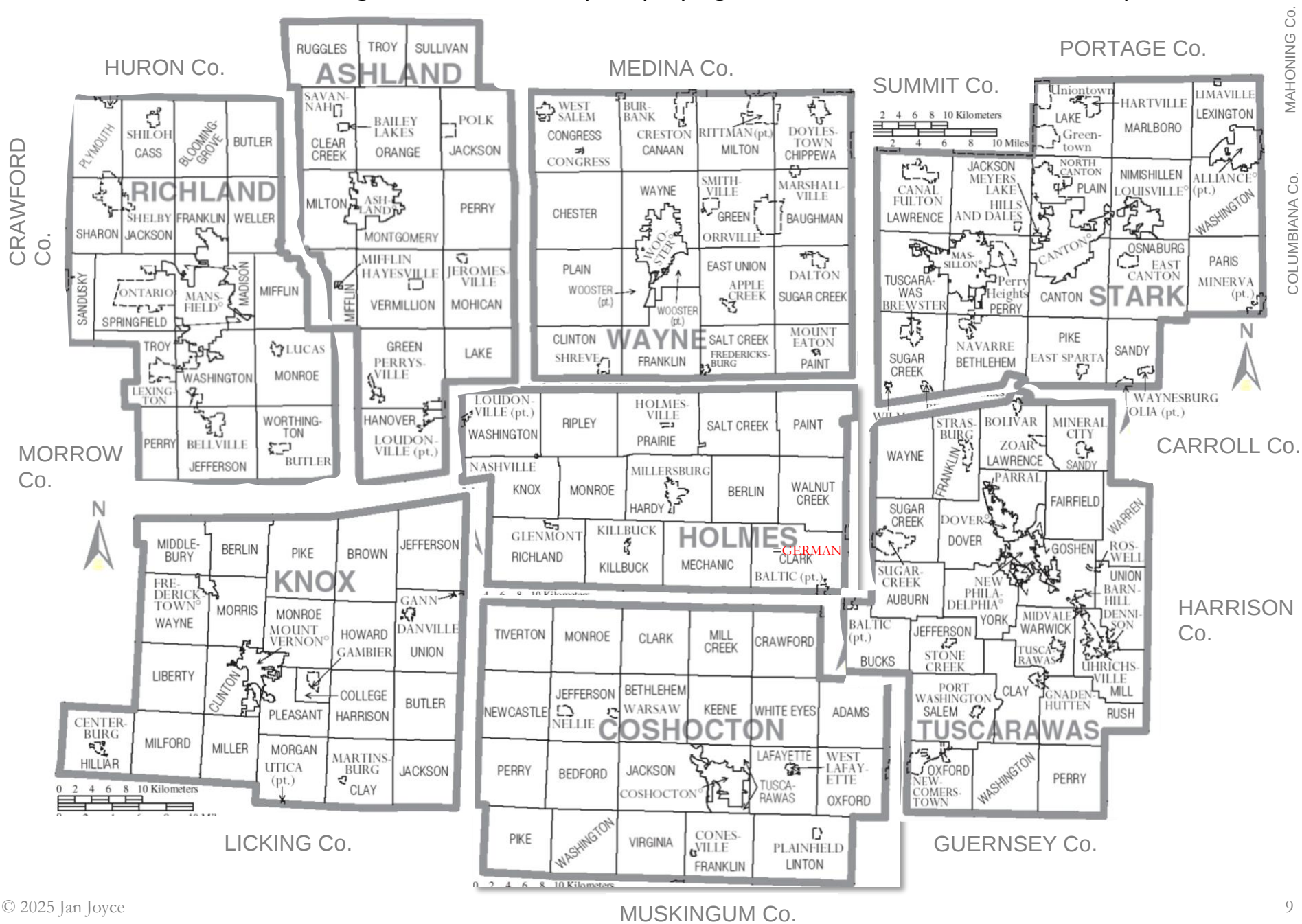

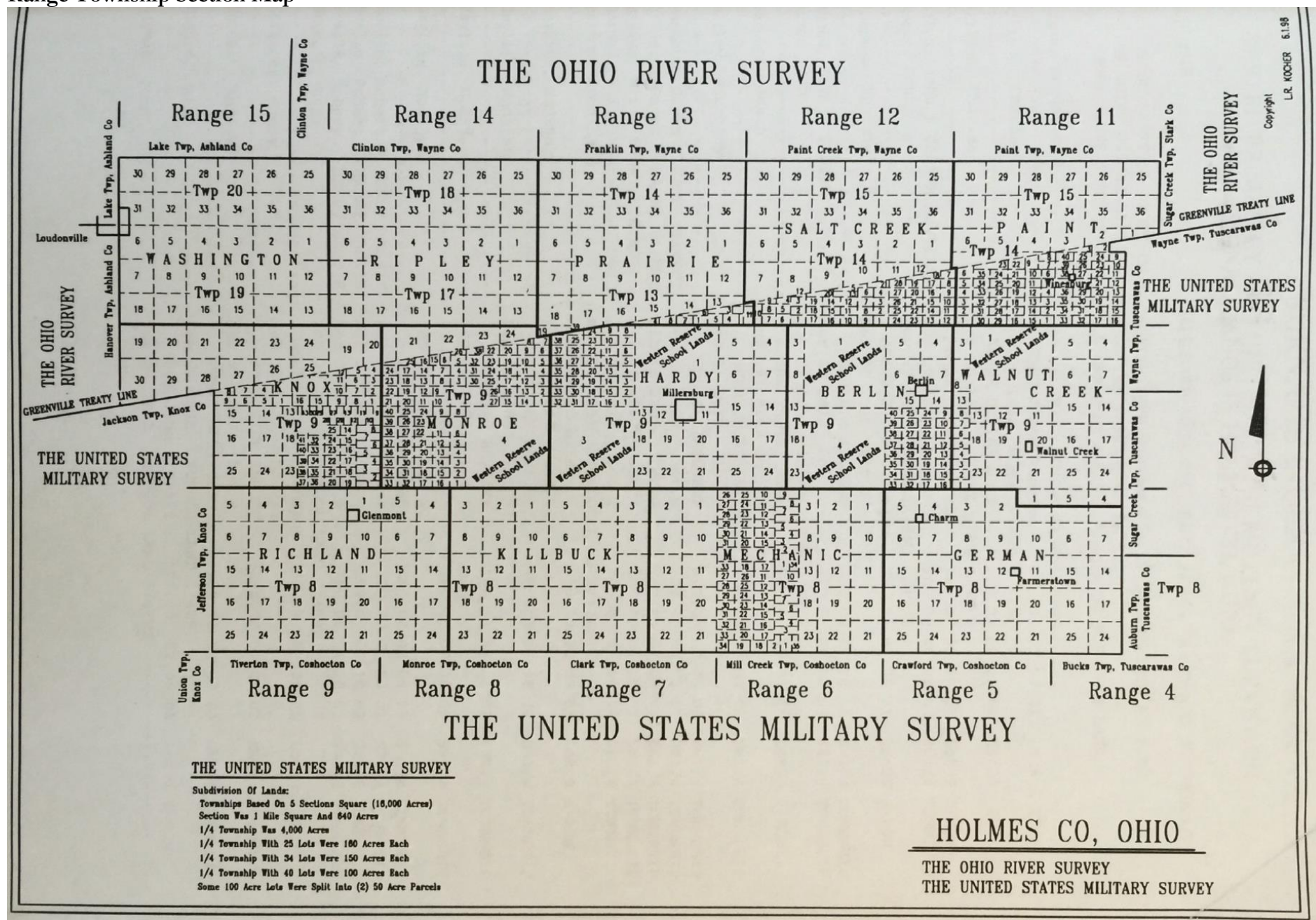
Holmes County was formed in 1824 in part from Coshocton. Richland Township, where David Dewitt resided, was a part of Coshocton that became Holmes. APPENDIX A

HOLMES COUNTY TAX RECORDS – BREAKDOWN BY YEAR AND TOWNSHIP

Holmes County Tax Research – All Surnames

NOTE: One of the incentives to buy land, or settle it, was that no taxes on real estate were administered until five (5) years after purchase. Thus, someone could own land and not be taxed on it. They would likely appear in chattel taxes.
