Each activity supports a different area of learning and development, helping to make reading both fun and meaningful.

Here's a quick overview of what's inside and how they can benefit your child:



Word Search - A fun way to reinforce new vocabulary from the story, improving spelling, concentration, and word recognition.



Drawing Prompt - Encourages creativity and visual thinking, helping your child to make personal connections to the text and explore characters or settings in more depth.



Writing Prompt Builds on imagination and writing skills by inviting your child to develop ideas related to the story. This helps deepen understanding of plot, character and theme, while practising sentence structure and language use.



School Fact File - Supports your child in feeling more confident about starting school. It allows them to gather and record useful information such as their teacher's and classroom name and uniform colour. This helps children to become familiar with their new environment and feel a sense of belonging.

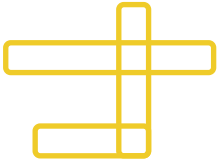


Sequencing Activity - Sequencing the school day will support your child in understanding routines and what to expect. By putting events such as registration, playtime, lunchtime, and home time in order, children learn how their day will flow, reducing worry and building independence.

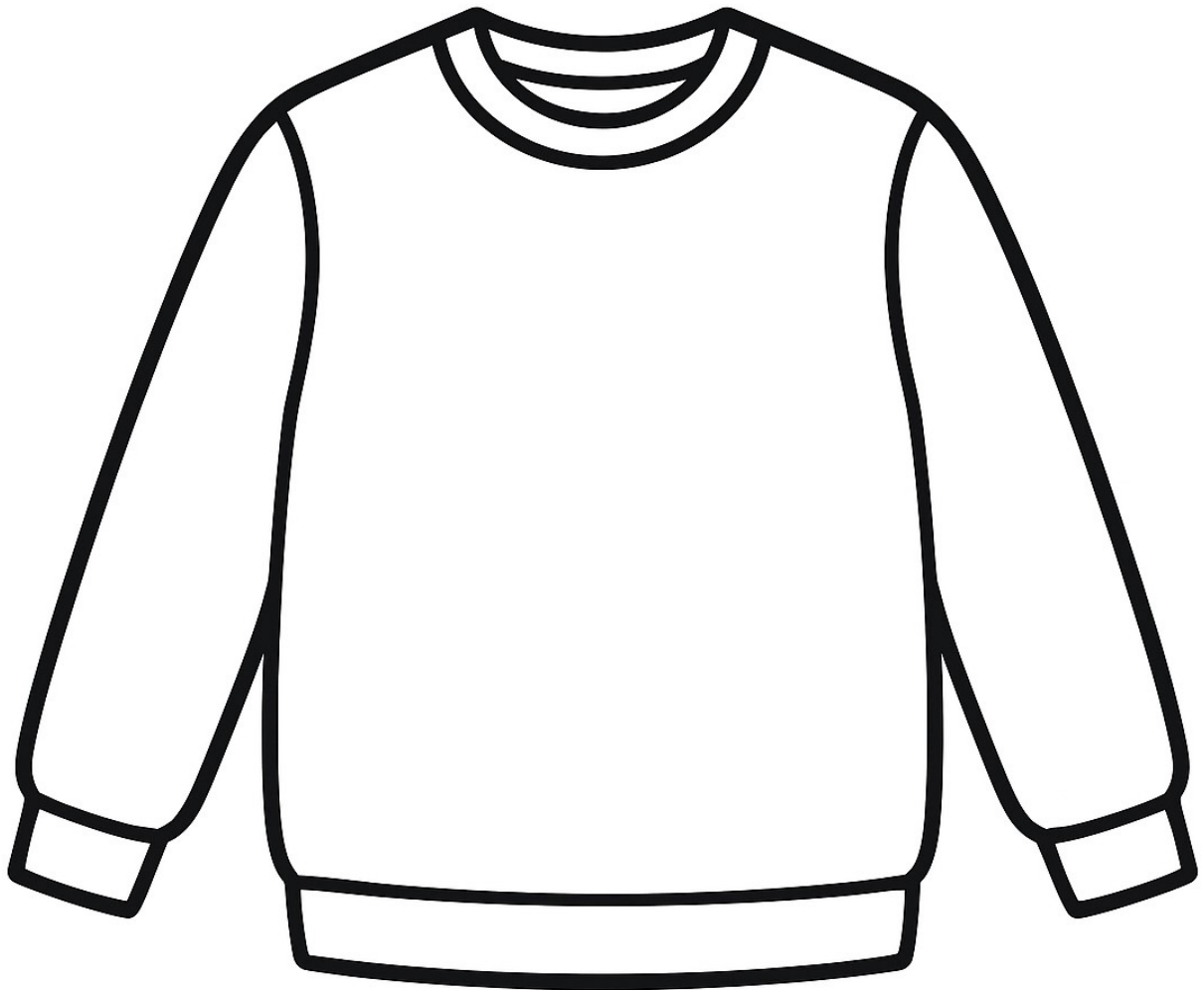

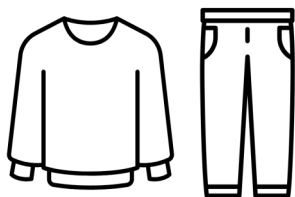

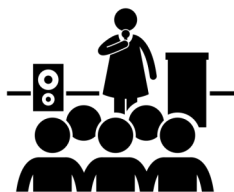
