Singing - A fun and effective way for children to learn letter order and recognition. It supports listening, concentration, and speech development, while giving children confidence as they begin early reading and writing. Parents can join in to make it an enjoyable, shared activity that strengthens learning through play!

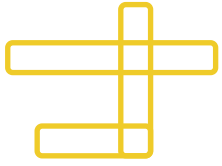


Vocabulary Help - Supports your child in understanding key words from the book. Talking about these words at home can boost confidence in reading and encourage more precise use of language in writing and conversation.



Handwriting - Supports your child's fine motor development and builds concentration. It also strengthens spelling and reading skills, as writing letters by hand reinforces how they look and sound. Encouraging your child to practise little and often will make writing more fluent and enjoyable, giving them confidence.

- *Silly Voices* - Use a robot, monster, or squeaky mouse voice.
- *Action Singing* - Clap, stamp, or jump for each letter.
- *Echo Singing* - Parent sings a line, child copies it back.
