Baldwin Windmill Days 2025 Parade Expectations and Waiver

- 1. Parking will **NOT** be allowed in the lineup area, please unload/drop off if needed in specified designated areas (which will be given with parade confirmation/instructions) and proceed to park on unmarked parade route streets or Millpond Park.
- 2. Political individuals/Candidates/Groups will be required to pay a non-refundable fee of \$100 to be paid <u>at time of registration</u>.
- 3. Late arrivals or registrations may be placed towards the end of the parade.
- 4. Horses/cattle/etc. will be placed towards the end of the parade. You are required to have a clean-up attendant, or your unit will NOT be allowed to travel the parade route.
- 5. Please register accurately for the parade. We plan for and account for all REGISTRED entries (space, numbering, etc). If you arrive with additional vehicles, you will only be allowed your registered parade entry.
- 6. Any disabled vehicle must be removed from the parade route as soon as possible.
- 7. Candy and other giveaways are permitted but should be handed out or tossed towards the curb. Not thrown at spectators or dropped on the street drawing children into parade traffic. We encourage you to politely direct children/parents back to the curb if they do not comply do not give the candy/giveaway.
- 8. All units are asked to maintain a brisk pace and avoid large gaps. One vehicle length between units is a good measure.
- 9. Do <u>NOT</u> unload/tear down/block traffic at the end of the parade route. Please head towards High School / Elementary School and tear down in the parking lot. Royalty <u>ONLY</u> may tear down at Gethsemane Lutheran Church parking lot.
- 10. Limited bathrooms will be available at the beginning of the parade route in Millpond Park and at the end of the parade route in the High School. There will be no available bathrooms in the parade lineup area. Please plan accordingly.
