Arrival – Sunday, 14th December 2025

Fly to: Maun International Airport, Botswana (MUB)

Arrive on: Sunday, 14th December 2025. Our friendly Camps Abroad team will be waiting at Maun Airport to meet all campers and escort them safely to camp.

Why: This gives your child time to settle in before camp begins on Monday, 15th December.

Optional extra support: If you'd like, we can arrange for your child to be met in Johannesburg and escorted on the 90-minute connecting flight up to Maun, Botswana.

Departure – Saturday, 20th December 2025

From: Maun International Airport, Botswana (MUB)

Internal flight: Please book the midday flight (or closest to midday) from Maun to O. R. Tambo International Airport, Johannesburg (JNB). Our staff will escort all campers on this internal flight to Johannesburg

International flight home: Book an evening departure from Johannesburg (JNB) on Saturday, 20th December 2025 back to the U.S.

How to Book Flights - Step by Step

1. Book your child's international flights:

From: Your home city in the U.S.

To: Johannesburg, South Africa (JNB) Book the connecting flight to Maun (MUB) for **Sunday, 14th December 2025.** Airlines that fly Johannesburg → Maun include Airlink and Air Botswana.

2. For the return journey:

Book the midday internal flight from Maun → Johannesburg on **Saturday, 20th December** (we travel together as a group). Book your child's evening international flight from Johannesburg (JNB) → U.S.

U.S. Travel Tips for Parents

- Allow plenty of time for transfers in Johannesburg when connecting to Maun.
- Make sure your child's passport is valid for at least 6 months after travel.
- Check whether your child needs a visa for Botswana or South Africa.
- ✓ If your child is travelling alone, book an Unaccompanied Minor service with the airline (if required).
