Good Day Prospective Member,

Thank you for your interest in or flying club. Below are the requirements for the use of the field. We fly electric, glow, and gas at the field and have multiple events throughout the year, please refer to our club website "somersetrc.org" for further information. As the weather gets nicer there are multiple club members that fly both weekend and weekday mornings.

The club has trainer planes with "Buddy Box Technology" and a computer flight simulator available for flight training. It is highly recommended new flyers get some flight time on a flight simulator prior to attempting to fly your model or the trainer planes. The learning curve will be greatly reduced with this approach.

For junior members the local 4-H has a program suited for their age with flight training and hands on 4H meetings. The link is included on this form for more information.

How to become a Somerset RC member

- 1. Obtain an AMA adult or youth membership. This is required by the county park and the club.
- 2. Obtain a Somerset County Park flying permit. The permit is required by all club and non-club member to fly at North Branch park.
- 3. Complete the FAA registration as "Hobby", along with the TRUST exam.
- 4. Complete the Somerset RC application form and email to Dave Szabo at Docz1159@gmail.com. Membership is not required to fly at the field, but if you are out of county, club membership will bring your Park flying permit costs down.
