Roads/Updates- Possible Action: Saving money for Pine Creek Road project, set to begin Spring 2026. Should be getting aid of \$46,000 from DOT. Curb and Gutter, with Blacktop. Parking lot, upper and lower will also be done with estimated cost of \$75-\$80,000.00. Part of this is to get into compliance for Handicap Access.
Mowing has been completed. Vehicles set for Plowing and Cole is making sure Maintenance issues are completed prior to his leaving.
Follow up will be done on pot hole on 190th (Pittman Hill) Tandom has been starting hard, so is down at Clare Repair for inspection.
