We were not aware that Travis might be Autistic until he was in the 4th grade, and he was not officially diagnosed with Autism Spectrum Disorder until the 8th grade. Travis did not keep it a secret that he was Autistic, but it wasn't usually the first thing people knew about him. Travis was just Travis, smart, funny and loving. While ASD presents its own challenges, Travis never let it stop him. Travis' passion for technology was a natural fit for his abilities. He was pursuing a career in Computer Networking.

After his passing on March 8, 2017, Travis' family and friends came together to fund this scholarship in hopes to bless others. It will be awarded every year in the honor of his memory. We have awarded eleven scholarships to eleven wonderful students thus far.

SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION

- One scholarship of \$2,000
- Two scholarships of \$1,000
- Scholarships will be awarded to three graduating Seniors from Chowchilla, Le Grand, Merced
 OR Madera high schools who have been accepted and committed to a two-year accredited
 college, four-year accredited college or trade or technical school.
- Scholarships will be awarded at the school's Baccalaureate ceremony, whenever possible.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must have autism spectrum disorder (ASD) diagnosis.
 OR
- Applicant must be pursuing a computer science field of study.
- Applicant must possess a GPA of 2.5 or higher.
