1. Drop Off / Pick Up Location

2. What Happens at Drop Off / Pick Up

When children are dropped off the site manager will give the parent a number relating to each child. This is so that if someone else is picking the children up they can tell Max the number(s) as confirmation that they are okay to pick up the children. This forms part of our safeguarding policy and must be strictly adhered to.

*We do not provide food. During the day we have 2 snack breaks and one lunch break as per the timetable. Please ensure that your child brings enough food that will give them lasting energy for the day, bearing in mind that they will be using more energy than a usual school day.

We have plenty of drinking water to refill water bottles.

4. Weather

It's likely to be warm and sunny but, please do keep an eye on the weather for the days you have booked. Although we will be outside as much as possible, there is still a chance of summer storms. In the event of severe weather, we do have ample indoor space at our disposal.

Please equip your children appropriately for the weather.

5. Medication

Hayfever – Please ensure that if your child suffers from hayfever that they have appropriate medication. ARU Writtle has a large variety of plants and trees which can trigger a more severe hayfever reaction than usual.

We can only administer medication that children bring along themselves, including antihistamines and painkillers.

If your child is bringing along emergency medication (e.g. asthma pump) then this can be looked after by either their instructor or the child themselves at the parents' discretion.
