SSEEO and American Stroke
Association (ASA) expanded pilot and
final evaluation (hospital data
included WI, IL, NH, OH and CO).

1655 calls & 109 follow-up surveys administered to 618 patients.

822 calls answered 649 by a survivor and 178 by a caregiver.

- Patients' biggest physical and mental challenges: fatigue, cognitive issues, and emotional disturbances.
- Patients' biggest social issues: therapy compliance, filling or taking prescriptions, and managing chronic conditions.
- More than half felt SS2S helped with stroke-related challenges and would recommend the program to others.
- Participants described SS2S using the words helped, hopeful, and connected.
