## THE ONLINE SEVEN-SESSION PROGRAM INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. Meet the students
- 2. Stroke survivor assessment
- 3. Students discuss assessment with stroke survivor
- 4. Student assessment and observation of agreed-upon functional activity
- 5. Students consult with stroke survivor about goals and interventions
- 6. Intervention with stroke survivor and plan for practice
- 7. Intervention follow-up with discharge/education/recommendations

Please note that this is part of a Master of Occupational Therapy program at North Central College in Naperville, IL and is a part of course curriculum. The students receive a grade/classroom credit. It is important that participants attend all noted times and sessions so the student and stroke survivor have a successful outcome.
