THE ONLINE SEVEN-SESSION PROGRAM INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:



1. Meet the students
2. Stroke survivor assessment
3. Students discuss assessment with stroke survivor
4. Student assessment and observation of agreed-upon functional activity
5. Students consult with stroke survivor about goals and interventions
6. Intervention with stroke survivor and plan for practice
7. Intervention follow-up with discharge/education/recommendations

Please note that this is part of a Master of Occupational Therapy program at North Central College in Naperville, IL and is a part of course curriculum. The students receive a grade/classroom credit. *It is important that participants attend all noted times and sessions so the student and stroke survivor have a successful outcome.*
