Important Information — Policies-Code of Conduct

Welcome ... Excited about joining our stables.

Horse Lover-

- · All riders must review, sign and follow barn rules
- Each rider learns new skills at his and her own pace.
- Must wear appropriate uniform for the Riding Program that you in.
- Dress appropriately for riding. Wear sports attire including long pants; jodhpurs
 are recommended, paddock boots, shirts that are not revealing, and sports bra if
 necessary.
- Respect trainers, instructors, and other stall members.
- Cancellation Policy-the stables requires 24 hour notice to cancel any riding program. Failure to give 24 hour notice will result in forfeiture of the program time and fee. No refund or credit will be given for failure to cancel or complete a lesson session.
- Increment Weather Plan--If there is bad weather we will follow the Madison protocol.
- All riding program must have a sign Liability waiver or online form
- It is a boarder's responsibility to ensure that all his/her guests have completely filled out and signed a release.
- Persons under 17 may not ride unsupervised without trainer's and parents' permission. Approved helmets with chin harness in place must be worn at all times for riders under 17 while mounted.
- Children under 17 "Daycare" are not to be left unattended at any time at the barn, unless PRIOR arrangements have been made. This includes lessons or barn time
- Starting June 1, 2019, the Stables policies will go into effect. The new policies are part of a congressional requirement mandating United State Equestrian Federation (USEF), as well as other amateur sports organizations and governing bodies, to implement policies and procedures that limit one-on-one interactions between minor athletes and adults who are not their parent/legal guardian. We designed these policies to work for equestrian sport, but please recognize that they are based on the uniform policies developed by the U.S. Center for SafeSport that will further protect minor athletes, under federal law. If a child is left alone with adult that isn't their parent/guardian they must have permission and pay the "DAYCARE" fee packages.
- Communication through Texting/Email must be done with all parties -- Parent/ Guardian, child, and trainer/instructor. These policies are designed to protect minors and adults, and other sports governing bodies across the country are enacting similar measures.
- Any lessons MUST be Scheduled through SIGN up GENIUS. Any communication with Child will not be taken due to who's paying for the lessons.
- Please use your own equipment and respect other people's property.
- Each person is responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their horses.
- Clean up manure immediately. Do not wait until after you ride.
- Treat others the way you want to be treated. (Would you want someone to criticize your appearance, clothes, or how you ride?)
- Refrain from loud, boisterous talk, inappropriate language, and other unbecoming conduct. (Profanity will Not be tolerated at the stables.)
- Demonstrate sportsmanship in the show ring, contests, lessons, and meetings. (Be modest in winning and generous in defeat.)

Proper Uniform Attire

Riding like other sports has a "uniform". This is not for appearance or a fashion show, but for the safety of the rider.

- Form fitting shirts tucked in. This allows instructors to see body position during lessons.
- Boots. NO fashion boots or Cowboy boots. It is recommended that riders invest in jod boots.
- Jodhpurs, while you can ride in jeans you will find that the inside seam will start to rub on your leg and most jeans have the "bling" on the back pockets that will damage the leather on the saddles. If you show up with bling jeans you will not be permitted to ride.
- Helmet, if you are under 17 you are required to wear a helmet in all lessons. This is for safety. We encourage adult riders to invest and wear a helmet to wear when mounted on the horse. NEVER buy a used helmet as you do not know the fall history and the stability of the helmet.
- NO jewelry such as dangly earrings and necklaces. These can become hung up on the saddle and can cause injury to the rider. If you must wear a medical alert bracelet, please make sure it fits snugly.
- Gloves are recommended to save wear and tear on your hands. There
 are a number of different types of gloves that are perfect for the season
 and for riding. Please check with an instructor if you have questions.
- No baggy shirts. These can become tangled in equipment and can lead to injury to the rider.

Beginner Level:

- MUST WEAR LONG PANTS!
- Best to have a closed toe shoes.
- Helmets SEI approved safety horseback riding helmets will be provided at the stables.
- Must wear a Shirt
- Hair pulled back neatly to fit under helmet.

Intermediate and Advanced Level for all Riders:

- Kentucky JODHPURS or LEGGINGS Jodhpurs must have keepers and worn with a belt
- BOOTS Jodhpur boots, paddock boots
- GLOVES Leather gloves required
- HELMETS SEI approved safety horseback riding helmets It is HIGHLY recommended for 17 yrs old and under.
- Shirt worn tucked in should fit neatly
- Whip
- Hair pulled back neatly

Please note, it is very important to wear proper attire, because it is not only safer, but will also help improve your riding ability. Using the proper equipment shows respect for the the sport and pride in your appearance. We expect all riders to come prepared with the correct attire every time they ride. There are a number of locations that you can purchase the above attire needed for your rider's lessons. If you need any help please do not hesitate to ask an instructor and we will guide you to success.


