Parent Code of Conduct

As a member of the North Texas Youth Football League Wichita Falls, I understand that I represent my child, our team, and the league. I agree to abide by the following Code of Conduct to help ensure a positive, safe, respectful, and development-focused environment for all participants.

Respect for Team Managers and Coaching Staff: Team managers and coaching staff are volunteers who donate their time, effort, and expertise to serve our youth. I agree to take practices and games seriously by ensuring my child is on time, prepared, and available as scheduled. I will pick up my child promptly at the conclusion of practices and games. I will communicate conflicts, concerns, or issues calmly and respectfully. I will follow proper channels for communication and never confront coaches during games or in front of players.

Respect for All Players: All players deserve encouragement, dignity, and equal respect. I agree to support and encourage all players, not just my own child. I will never insult, criticize, belittle, or ridicule any child. I will promote confidence, effort, teamwork, and sportsmanship.

Respect for NTYFL WF Personnel and Volunteers: Parents set the example for athletes. I agree to treat all board members, staff, officials, and volunteers with respect and courtesy. I will follow league rules, policies, and procedures at all times. I will address concerns through proper league processes, not through confrontation or public disputes.

Respect for Other Parents and Spectators: A positive environment requires mutual respect. I agree to treat all parents and spectators with courtesy and professionalism. I will avoid verbal altercations, arguments, or confrontations. I will refrain from gossip, rumors, or negative commentary that harms the league culture.

Sportsmanship and Sideline Behavior: I understand that my behavior directly impacts the experience of all children. I agree to display good sportsmanship at all times. I will refrain from profanity, aggressive language, or unsportsmanlike conduct. I will never challenge officials, coaches, or league staff during games.

Communication Standards: I agree to use respectful, appropriate language in all verbal, written, and electronic communication. I will follow established grievance and complaint procedures. I will never use social media to attack players, parents, coaches, officials, or the league.

Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to verbal or written warnings, removal from sidelines or events, suspension from games or practices, and/or removal from league activities. Disciplinary actions will be determined by the NTYFL WF Board in accordance with league bylaws and policies.
