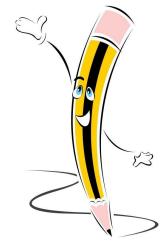


ABOUT LEKHA INK

Lekha: A Brief History

Jyoti Yelagalawadi, an avid storyteller and writer since her youth, has always believed that children and youth can accomplish anything by using their imaginations. One of her life long dreams has been to bring unique and good quality books written for or by children.

She started Lekha Publishers in 2002 when she saw the poems written by one of her friends, a volunteer in her neighborhood school. After noticing that no traditional publishing company would publish this extremely unique book of poems, she researched and found out the best way to publish Richard Makenzie's *Poems From The Playground*. After that she published *Laugh With Dinosaurs* and a couple of other books, that she had written, under the company's banner.



Jyoti started a writing program as an experiment in the summer of 2006, when a friend of Jyoti asked her to guide her daughter and a few other children in the art of writing. Jyoti's wonderful experience that summer inspired her to continue the writing center as a inseparable part of her independent publishing company, which was later incorporated as Lekha Ink, Corp. Since then she and her staff have guided and published over 5000

young authors in anthologies. She has personally guided 45 authors, both young authors and adults, in creating their own books.

How Publishing with Lekha Works

Lekha is a small, independent publishing house, and simply cannot afford to operate in the way of a traditional publishing house, which covers all the initial costs, then pays the author a percentage of the book sales. Lekha authors must cover the initial costs of book preparation and pay to print the first run of the book, however small or large it may be. However, Lekha is not to be considered a typical vanity publisher. Unlike most vanity publishers, who will publish anything that they are paid to, Lekha is selective about the works we publish. Our professional publishing team makes sure that every book we publish is of massmarket appeal and quality. We expect the books we publish to do well and be successful. In addition, we work with our authors to market and sell their books, to get as much exposure and sales as possible for our authors.

Since we are not a traditional-style publishing house, we understand that our authors are making a big I investment by choosing Lekha but let us assure you that we are one of the most affordable options out there. We know that the publishing process can be confusing to authors who have not worked with a publishing company like ours before. We hope that this brochure will help to inform you about the basics of publishing with Lekha.



WHY LEKHA INK?

There are many vanity publishers available who will readily publish your book. Self – publishing is very easy too, so why choose an independent publisher like Lekha Ink?

One can always get books published by "vanity publishers" or "self-publish" a book by sending a copy of their unpolished, unedited manuscript to a printer but the book that is received from a printer or a vanity publisher may not be marketable, and is not likely to sell many copies unless the author devotes an significant amount of personal time into book sales, such as going doorto door selling books, developing one's own author website, and paying for expensive print and online marketing services. That is where Lekha comes in. We help authors with the creation (editing, formatting, design, finding and communicating with a printer) and the marketing and sales of their books, to give them a much better chance at becoming successful. Lekha can offer you polished book preparation, marketing services, distribution services, book signing opportunities, book review solicitation, and sales opportunities far beyond what online sites or vanity publishers offer.
