NEW! BIRTH TO FIVE CDA CREDENTIAL NOW AVAILABLE!

Learn More About The CDA EXAM

- The CDA Exam is a computer-based test.
- You must take the exam IN PERSON at the Pearson Vue location.
- You will have 1 hour and 45 minutes to answer 65 multiple choice questions.
- As of 8/1/25, you are required to schedule and complete the CDA exam BEFORE the observation.
- Utilize the CDA course textbooks and study guides provided by Miss Trish's to prepare and review.



FEATURED CHILDREN'S BOOK

The Mitten by Jan Brett is a classic story of a little boy whose lost mitten is found by some curious forest animals.

- **-Reading:** Use sequencing words to retell the story; "First, Second, Third..."
- **-Math:** Count the animals as they discover the lost mitten.
- **-Art**: Design a mitten that would be easier to find in the snow.
- -Social/ Emotional: Brainstorm things you can do to help a friend if something they love is lost.


