

The Council for Professional Recognition has announced the addition of "the Child Development Professional ™: The Best Next Step" in credentialing for Early Childhood Educators. This credential will be designed to recognize experienced educators who have already earned the CDA, and who deomonstrate excellence in a variety of areas including leading in classroom practice, mentoring peers, and improving quality in programs. The Council will be collecting feedback throughout the year and expects to set credential guidelines in 2026.


