“Swiftwater Rescue Boat Operator”

This course is designed to introduce students to boat operation on swiftwater. During the course students gain experience reading moving water and operating boats in current. Using both a motor and paddles, students will practice such skills as use and avoidance of hydraulics, ferrying across current, and obstacle navigation will be practiced in Class I and II whitewater. Students then progress to operating both up and down stream in Class III and above whitewater. Other exercises include operation scenarios and multiple boat operations. We are unlike the others; a total of 36 skill sets are taught and delivered. This program exceeds NIMS and FEMA task-level programs. FEMA Task books are available upon request.

Tuition: \$500.00

Prerequisites: Minimum age: 18 years of age- Swiftwater Technician

Personal Equipment: Full wetsuit or drysuit, lightweight water or kayak helmet, US Coast Guard-approved Type III or V lifejacket/PFD, thick-soled water booties or tennis shoes, gloves.

Team Equipment: Inflatable boat (12ft minimum w/25 hp outboard motor minimum), fuel, and paddles. A maximum of 4 students per boat.
