# INSTRUCTIONAL CLASSES



ODR offers numerous instructional classes to teach you basic outdoor skills to include knots, backcountry baking, navigation, wilderness first aid and much more. No experience necessary to attend. All courses are located at ODR unless otherwise noted. All participants must pre-register at ODR prior to class.

## BOATER SAFETY COURSE

**Cost: \$15 | Age: 21+ | Max people: 8 | Jul: 10, 24. Aug: 6, 20. Sep: 4, 18. Oct: 1, 15, 28 at 11 AM**

To rent a motorized boat from ODR, all renters are required to have completed the **in-class Boater Safety Course (BSC)** at ODR for the specific boat being rented. Topics covered include how to properly tow, launch and recover our boats in a local waterway, operating instructions, troubleshooting measures and proper check in/out procedures. **Proof of drivers license required.** Patrons must present their **California Boater Card** issued by the California State Parks Division of Boating and Waterways (DBW) at time of registration. More info to apply for the card can be found online at <https://californiaboatercard.com/applynow/>. Please note that to obtain the card, you must take an approved boating safety course approved by the State of California and the National Association of State Boating Law Administrators listed online at <https://californiaboatercard.com/courses/> (ODR recommends the BoatU.S. free course at <http://www.boatus.org/california/>). **\*CA Boater Card requirement listed above must be completed prior to BSC registration with ODR.**

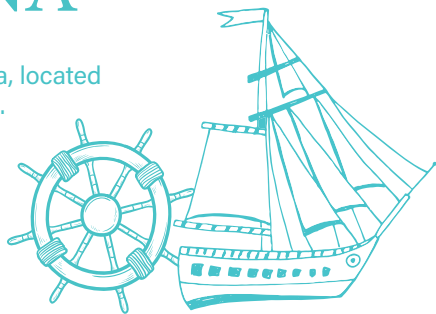

### Camp Trailer Policy

\*Must have completed a Camp Trailer Orientation Course (CTOC) with ODR prior to rental. \*Renters must have 1/2 ton chassis with 8000+ towing capacity and breaking control box installed in the vehicle. \*All trailer tanks MUST be entirely emptied and sanitized PRIOR to return. \*FAM Camp has \$5 dump station. Up to 1 day rent will be applied for any cleaning needed after return to include un-emptied black and gray water tanks. Reservations for all trailers can be made 90 days in advance for Active Duty, 30 days for all others. Minimum requirement for reservation is 3-business days prior to date of rental. The fee to cover the entire rental is due upon reservation equipment. \*Travis Outdoor Recreation is not responsible for propane tank levels, hitches or electric adapters. \*\*Renter must have insurance that will cover boat or trailer rental, and should stop by ODR for a pre-inspection prior to date of rental to ensure there are no issues with vehicle and boat/trailer hookup. Ask about travel distance limitations which may apply for both boats and trailers\*\*
