Our program exposes youth to the wonderful field of ironworking. We teach participants the fundamental skills, knowledge, and abilities necessary to move forward with an ironworking career.

Program Length

The program lasts approximately one year. High School students begin their ironworking journey in June of their 11th grade school year. They learn and work throughout the summer and decrease their time to a 2-3 day work schedule when school resumes.
