The Elements of Abundance Announces "Cowboys in Accra: Black in the Saddle Live" as Part of Return. Connect. Build. – Ghana Edition

Compton Cowboys, Author Louis C. Hook, HRM Notse Nii Nortey Owuo IV, and Marie Wini of XP Riding Ghana Unite for an Intimate Evening of Storytelling, Heritage, and Diaspora Connection at Treehouse in Osu

Accra, Ghana – December 11, 2025 – The Elements of Abundance (The Elements) is proud to present "Cowboys in Accra: Black in the Saddle Live," a signature cultural event under its Return. Connect. Build. – Ghana Edition series. The evening will feature the world-renowned Compton Cowboys, author Louis C. Hook, HRM Notse Nii Nortey Owuo IV, and Marie Wini of XP Riding Ghana, in a live conversation moderated by media personality Ivy Prosper and produced in partnership with Valid Entry Entertainment.

Hosted in the late afternoon at Treehouse in Osu, Accra, on Tuesday, December 30, 2025, from 4:00–7:00 PM, the event brings Black equestrian heritage to the forefront—connecting stories from the streets of Compton to the coastal city of Accra and honoring the often-overlooked role of Black horsemen across history.

"Black in the Saddle is about reclaiming a story that has always been ours," said **Louis C. Hook**, author of the book at the center of the evening's program. "From Compton to Ghana, the thread is the same: community, resilience, and the healing power of horses. Bringing this conversation to Accra feels like closing a historical loop and opening a new chapter at the same time."

The **Compton Cowboys**, a collective of Black riders from Compton, California, are known globally for their motto, "*Streets raised us. Horses saved us.*" Their work with horses, youth, and community has challenged stereotypes and reshaped the narrative of what it means to come from Compton.

"Standing in Accra with our people, talking about horses and history, isn't just a 'moment'—it's a homecoming," said **Randy Savvy** of the Compton Cowboys. "We're not just riding for ourselves; we're riding for every ancestor whose story was never told."

The event also centers Ghana's own equine traditions and cultural leadership. **HRM Notse Nii Nortey Owuo IV**, the king of Osu, will offer historical and spiritual context on Ghanaian horse culture and the ways in which heritage, chieftaincy, and community remain intertwined.

Bringing a contemporary, local perspective to the conversation, **Marie Wini of XP Riding Ghana** will share insights from her work with riders and horses in Accra, highlighting how equestrian spaces are evolving as places of learning, healing, and cross-cultural exchange. The discussion will be guided by **Ivy Prosper**, whose storytelling and media work have amplified African and diaspora narratives to global audiences.

Return. Connect. Build. is about more than tourism—it's about tending to the emotional, cultural, and economic bridges between Africa and the diaspora," said **The Elements of Abundance** co-founders. "With Cowboys in Accra, we're using horses, history, and storytelling to remind us that our paths have always been linked, even when the world tried to separate our stories."

Produced by **Valid Entry Entertainment**, the experience is designed as both intimate and content-rich: a space where attendees can listen deeply, ask questions, interact with the panelists, and leave with both memories and tangible keepsakes.
