If a rider falls from a horse to the ground it will generally be a distance of from 3 1/2' to 5 ½ feet, and impact may result in injury to the rider. Horseback riding/driving is the only sport where one much smaller, weaker predator animal, the human, tries to control and become one unit of movement with another much larger, stronger prey animal, the horse, with each having a limited understanding of one another. If a horse is frightened or provoked it may divert from its training and act according to its natural survival instincts which may include, but are not limited to, stopping short, changing direction, or speed at will; shifting its weight from side to side, bucking, rearing, biting, kicking or running from danger.
