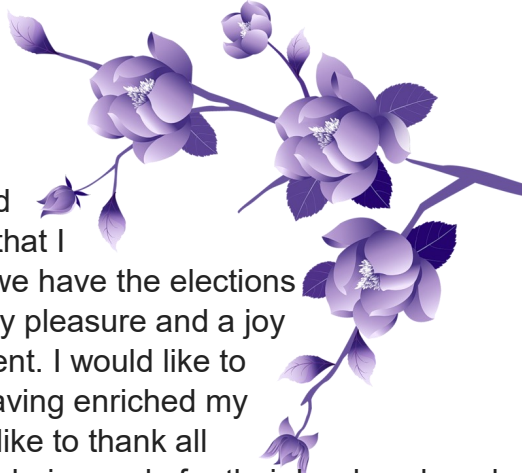




President's

Tonight's program was a Member Trunk Show.

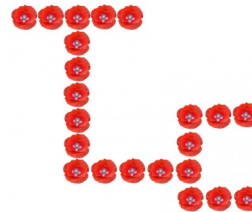

I am not sure when it is but the Shop Hop is coming. Now, I don't know about the rest of you but I tend to buy a bit too much to carry. So for April's Sew Social you will need the following

Fabric requirements : these fabrics should play nicely with each other, some contrast

1/4 yard fabric one

1/3 yard fabric two

1/4 yard of fabric three

1/2 yard fabric four

1/4 yard fusible interfacing

Cutting Instructions

Fabric 1) 2 - 5 1/4 inch x 16 3/4 inch rectangles

Fabric 2) 2 - 8 1/4 inch x 16 3/4 inch rectangles

Fabric 3) 2 - 2 1/2 inch by width of fabric

Fabric 4) 1 - 13 inch x 32 1/4 rectangle

Fusible interfacing) 2 - 1 1/2 inch by width of fabric

2 - 5 1/4 inch x 16 3/4 inch rectangles

2 - 8 1/4 inch x 16 3/4 inch rectangles



Also bring your favorite sewing items and a small dish to share. You can also work on a project of your own if you so desire.
