9. Explanation of the setup and take down of the quilts. *Cris Ross & LaDonna will go through this information.*



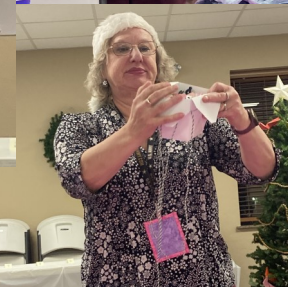
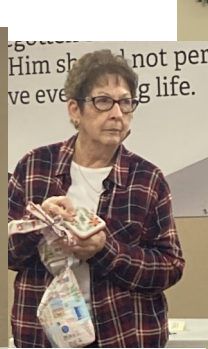

Anke opened the most gifts but that is because everyone was stealing hers.



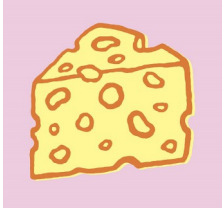
# Party Time!!!

## Pineapple and Cheese Casserole... Jean Petersen



9x13 inch casserole (or a little smaller)

### Ingredients

14 Oz can crushed pineapple

1 ½ c grated sharp cheddar cheese

6 T flour

¾ c sugar

1 sleeve Ritz crackers crushed

1 stick (8T) real butter (unsalted) melted

1. Oven 350 degrees
2. Grease casserole
3. Drain pineapple, reserving the juice
4. Heat flour, sugar, and juice in small pan, stirring until thickened
5. Spread pineapple in casserole, spread cooked mixture over pineapple, spread cheese on top of pineapple mixture
6. Melt butter and mix in crushed Ritz crackers. Sprinkle on top of mixture
7. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until top is golden brown
