Nancy: Perimeter must be no less than 40 inches and no more than 200 inches


Barbara: No black fabric maybe used

Quilt Show Information

- 2. Collect **fat quarters** to give to Jan for the Fat Quarter baskets. Remember a **Fat Quarter** is quarter of fabric is a one-fourth yard cut that usually measures 18" x 22".
- 3. Collect items for the Baskets.
- 4. Continue making clothes for Penny.
- 5. Collect Door Prizes to be given away during the guilt show
