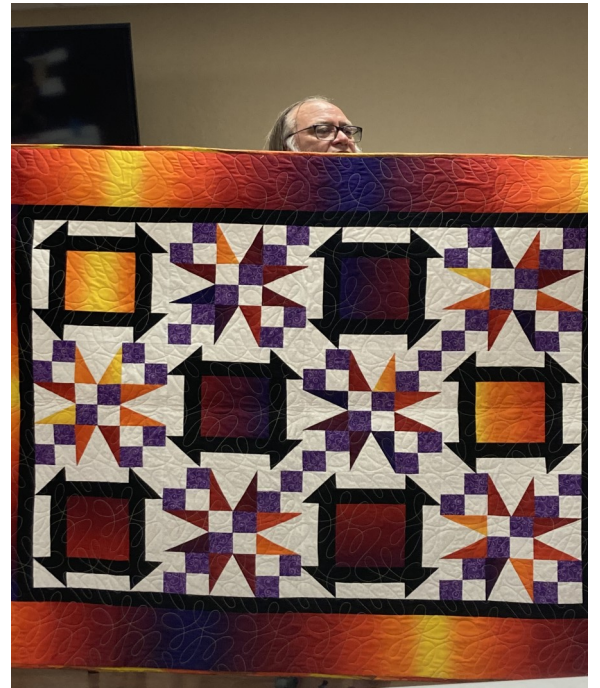


Quilt Counseling
