The Buyer agrees to provide a life-long commitment, comfortable environment, prompt medical attention, proper grooming and responsible care. The Buyer promises to provide a safe environment for the puppy, and never allow the puppy to roam freely without proper fencing or supervision. The Seller strongly recommends that the puppy be microchip in order to facilitate his return if lost or stolen.

The Seller guarantees this puppy to be of sound health at the time of this sale. A health record of all shots and worming will be provided by the Seller. The Buyer agrees to take this puppy to a licensed veterinarian of his choice within one week for a physical and examination.

Buyer assumes all responsibility for all bills. If a genetic disease is discovered in the puppy, a letter from your vet stating the nature of the disease and/or disorder will need to be provided to the breeder. The letter will have to state that this is a genetic disorder. The Breeder reserves the right to discuss the health conditions with the veterinarian. If your puppy is determined to have a genetic disorder, Breeder will reimburse the cost for treatment (up to the price of the puppy). Breeder assumes no direct responsibility for any medical bills for the puppy.

This guarantee is for genetic diseases and disorders only. This guarantee extends from the date of birth of the puppy and is valid until it's first birthday.

If the puppy is euthanized or in any way disposed of, without a second opinion from the sellers veterinarian, The Buyer waives all rights to a reimburse.

If the puppy should die from a suspected congenital defect within the first year of its date of birth, an autopsy must be performed at the Buyers expense by a licensed veterinarian acceptable to the Sellers own veterinarian. If the autopsy shows a congenital defect as the reason of the death, Breeder will reimburse the buyer (up to the price of the puppy). Breeder assumes no direct responsibility for any medical bills for the puppy.

It is structurally and temperamentally suited as a companion and/or obedience puppy. Training classes are recommended for a happy relationship between the dog and the family.
