## Acceptance of last meeting's minutes

-Perhaps we can do one Hallett HPDE Region event next year due to the interest of the Parade. -Brian Thomas mentioned that the interest in Club Racing has declined nationwide. Also, there is no HPDE at the Parade, only a two day autocross.
