MESSAGE FROM THE BOARD

So, for the first year in quite a few years, we are having winter. Our snow contractor has had some "getting started issues", which have been addressed by the board and our management company. We will continue to monitor their performance during any subsequent snow storms throughout the remainder of the season.

At our December Board meeting we approved the 2026 budget, and despite significant increases in many of our costs, the increase in monthly HOA fees is only \$8. The 2026 monthly coupon book has been sent out to all owners reflecting the new HOA amount. If you pay by ACH/direct debit you can of course disregard the coupon book.

We have now had the entire HVAC system successfully replaced in the Club House and so far there have been no reported issues.

One reminder we have to continue to announce; **PLEASE stop raising the temperature on the thermostats and leaving them raised** when you leave the building. Heating an empty Clubhouse while not being used, especially the size of ours, is costly and a tremendous waste of money and energy. So, remember - turn the thermostats back down when you are finished using the Clubhouse before you leave.

The new cleaning contractor has started and will normally clean weekly, every Saturday.

The Board continues to work with the NJDOT on the easement for the handicapped sidewall design at our front gate. We have presented what we think is a fair estimate of the cost of this project to our community and believe the state is working with us in a cooperative manner.

The next HOA meeting is scheduled for Tuesday January 20th at 6pm in the Clubhouse

PLEASE do not remove any Social Committee notices from the Clubhouse bulletin board unless you are the one who put it up.


Next social committee meeting is Monday January 5th at 11:30am. ALL are welcome to attend, especially highlighting that invitation to our many new Village Grande owners.

- Do not leave a car in your driveway or your driveway will not be able to be cleared.
- Please **do not call** the board asking when will my driveway be cleared: **it will be cleared according to the posted zone map.**
- The Clubhouse parking lot may be used to park a vehicle that can not be garaged during a snow storm, BUT please park in the spaces across from the Clubhouse so the contractor can keep most of the lot clear. And please **remove** your vehicle once your driveway has been cleared.
