

STONEBROOKE BASKETBALL COURT GUIDELINES AND RULES

THE BASKETBALL COURT IS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF STONEBROOKE RESIDENTS. ALL GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT AT ALL TIMES.

1. As a courtesy to neighbors, court use is limited to daylight hours only.
2. To optimize neighborhood use of the court, formal league practices and games are not allowed.
3. During high traffic times, sharing of the court and taking turns with neighbors is requested.
4. No animals are allowed on the court.
5. Motorized vehicles of any type are not allowed on the court. *
6. Dangerous and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated, including, but not limited to damage to any structure or equipment, public intoxication, fighting, bullying, and rough play.
7. Violation of these rules are subject to fines and may lead to suspension of recreational privileges, as per Article 7, 7.1 (b) of the StoneBrooke Owners' Association Bylaws.

*This excludes vehicles used for property maintenance.
