STONEBROOKE BASKETBALL COURT GUIDELINES AND RULES

THE BASKETBALL COURT IS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF STONEBROOKE RESIDENTS. ALL GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT AT ALL TIMES.

- 1. As a courtesy to neighbors, court use is limited to daylight hours only.
- 2. To optimize neighborhood use of the court, formal league practices and games are not allowed.
 - 3. During high traffic times, sharing of the court and taking turns with neighbors is requested.
 - 4. No animals are allowed on the court.
 - 5. Motorized vehicles of any type are not allowed on the court. *
- 6. Dangerous and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated, including, but not limited to damage to any structure or equipment, public intoxication, fighting, bullying, and rough play.
- 7. Violation of these rules are subject to fines and may lead to suspension of recreational privileges, as per Article 7, 7.1 (b) of the StoneBrooke Owners' Association Bylaws.

*This excludes vehicles used for property maintenance.
