As we've shared, this month we are marking 50 years on the full-time staff of Cru (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ.)

He is returning home with copies of our ministry guidebook <u>A Grander Story</u> in Spanish. We plan to stay in touch via video conferencing and continue our strategic partnership. Our hope and plan is to see spiritual movement raised up among faculty on that university campus. Please pray with us for our Chilean friends and their vision for sharing the good news of God's love and forgiveness in their community.
