today understands a great revival is emerging in the global south - Africa, South Asia, South America - and even China. At the same time missions are very slow going in what was once the "Christian West."

Over spring break 17 students, 2 professors, and 7 Cru staff traveled to Belgium, from March 8 to 16. We came from Indianapolis and Chicago and our purpose was to bring the gospel (again) to the campuses of Europe specifically, Belgium. Once these campuses were places where students primarily studied the Bible and theology. Like many schools in the US, a worldview that ignores God has taken hold among the students and faculty here.



But students and faculty are open to talking. Besides meeting with a few previous professor contacts, Jenny and Abby, our UIndy professor friend were introduced to half a dozen other business professors. The students interacted with their peers at the University of Antwerp and KU-Leuven. In all the team initiated conversations 193 times, had 147 spiritual conversations with 77 of those leading to gospel presentations and we met people from 22 countries.
