#### a. Standard dues check collection and deposits

Terms to talk about standard process with dues and deposits.

Pick up checks, then deposit them. Chris to take checks to bank. Joe picks up mail then gives to Chris. If the treasurer is unable to take to DFCU, then the president will help deposit the checks

until the treasurer is able to deposit. If president is unavailable to pick up the mail, treasurer will help.

Possible stripe account and pass transaction fee to residents to use the system as an additional payment option. Send email and Facebook notification that a digital payment option is available.

To set up stripe account - JOE

Motion to setup and vote passed

#### b. Dues Collection for Past Due - and updates

2023: dues collection is complete/closed

2024: 11 people remain past due. They have individually agreed upon dates for payment. Delinquent payers need to have a signed contract indicating they recognize they are overdue and a mutually agreed upon date they will become current.

Past due process:

Electronic notification and initial letter to remind them, without late fee Second reminder letter via US Mail, now with late fee Contract between person and board, if arrangements need to be made. Collections if necessary.

Claim: Neighborhood directory out of date. Joe says directors have contact info for all residents.

Motion to send out a mailing to collect updated resident contact information, and to share HOA and neighborhood information, including website URL and community communication.

Send out mailings and have a notification sent out digitally

We can verify ownership on city records.

VOTE for formal US Mail to residents to verify ownership, email and phone. Omit board members. Vote passes unanimously.

#### c. Identify contracts that need renewal/quotes for 2025 and beyond

Trugreen 1% increase. They let us save if we pay a year in advance. They do a good job - motion: to renew with Trugreen - passes

i. Incumbent is TruGreen - VOTE passed for new contract with TruGreen

- II. Landscaping of Entrances Get bids for vote at March Meeting
  - i. Incumbent is Fire Guy

- ii. Need two additional bids. Ryan Kurrle has specs
- III. True Property Service Contract valid through 2028.

# d. Items we need taken care of by City of FH (for M. Bridges to help)

- Cracks in concrete and some things are pitted. No salt on new roads for 2 years.
- No solicitation sign needs to be replaced on Hunters Whip.
- Trees that have died along Drake and on Farmington Rd. need to be removed and replaced.
- Electrical feed to Carriage Hill has a surging issue. Needs to be fixed.
- Creek in park 1 and park 2 need clean up from water main break. we need this in writing from the city to respond formally. Write a letter and get a response from the city and county. Talk with Eric Gould to discuss the background re: the city and creeks.
- Send a list to Mike Bridges to help the city get the ball rolling to avoid going to court.
- Park 2 dislodged concrete storm drain culvert needs to be replaced. The city has stated that it is not their responsibility to fix. Need this to be put in writing by the city.
- Flooding occurring on the Spring Hill
