Purpose: To express creativity! To have fun! To show support for positive mental health!

Who May Participate:

All students in grades 4-12 who live in or go to school in Cheltenham Township.

<u>Contest Rules</u>:

- Entries must contain a positive Mental Health message. It can be brief. (Examples: things you do for yourself and others, seeking help from people and services, making good choices and avoiding substances, etc.).
- No negative messages. Be positive!
- No threats or scare tactics.
- No inappropriate or discriminatory language or symbols and no name calling (ex. "Don't be stupid" or "Be crazy for mental health").
- No personal/private advertisements.
- Choose your medium crayon, pen, pencil, paint, markers, computer graphics, photography (if people or pets are included, they must **ALL** sign a release form). Art may be in black and white or color.
- Submissions should be student work only.
- Be **original** and submit **your own** work. No copyrighted or trademarked characters, logos, artwork or graphics.
- Limit of one entry per student.
- Anything too detailed might be difficult to see, even on a billboard.
- Do not place your name or identifying information on the front of the design page, so that judging may occur without bias. Student information will accompany the artwork separately, through the **permission slip which must be submitted with the entry.**
